The TA 101 is an internationally recognized course that provides the introductory overview and concepts of Transactional Analysis.

Transactional Analysis is widely recognized as a way to understand ourselves and how we relate with others. It is also a method used by many in the helping professions, such as teachers, counsellors, psychologists, the medical profession and in voluntary and community groups. The TA 101 course is open to anyone who wants to improve their relationships with friends, family and work colleagues. Upon completion of the TA101, a certificate will be issued from the International Transactional Analysis Association.

The TA 101 course is also a pre-requisite for those wanting to become a Certified Transactional Analyst, and who then wish to pursue registration as a psychotherapist with the Psychotherapists Board of Aotearoa New Zealand.

The full Certified Transactional Analysis (psychotherapy) programme will be offered in Hastings in 2017.
